

PSALM 15 John Bertalot for Fence Parish Church for 12th March, 2006

Gospel: Mark 8: 31 - end.

*The refrain melody from bar 2 is played once by the organ, sung (with the intro) once by the ladies,
then repeated by congregation and choir.*

It is then sung once by all in between each pair of verses (which are sung by the choir in unison).
